

'Trees a Crowd'

Materials

- [101™ – Artist's Cement - Heavy](#)
- [Perfect Pigments™ – Dark Green](#)
- [Mica D'Lights – Silver](#)
- [Great Tape™](#)
- Glossy dark cardstock – Black, Hunter Green, or Navy
- Christmas charms
- Toothpick, brush or palette knife

Directions

1. Apply [101™ – Artist's Cement - Heavy](#) to the glossy stock using a pointed tool – toothpick, palette knife, etc.
2. Begin by 'drawing' the tree trunk, and then add tiny branches, picking up more 101 as you progress up the tree – fattest branches to smallest.
3. As you progress, apply a drop of Perfect Pigments Acrylic Paint – Dark Green to the tip of the tool and drag it through the 101, creating the green of the branches. Don't add too much, as the effect is supposed to be heavy snow on the branches.
4. While wet, embellish cement using [Mica D'Lights](#) – Silver, beads, sequins and/or ribbon.
5. Mount all layers together using [Great Tape™](#) onto a card.
