

Glass Ornaments

As Seen on HGTV'S Carol Duvall



Materials

- [Jewelz - Sparkling Mica Pigments](#)
- [Duo Adhesive](#)
- [Paintbrush - Detail](#)
- [Perfect Pigments - Black](#)
- [Gildenglitz](#)
- [Fine Liner](#)
- Clear glass ornament
- Plastic cup

Directions

1. Remove the metal cap & hook from glass ornament.
2. Pour in [Duo Adhesive](#) and coat inside of ornament completely by turning until the inside is covered.
3. Turn ball upside down and place it in a plastic cup to allow the excess adhesive to drain out.
4. Let it dry until clear. This may take 30 to 60 minutes.
5. Apply [Jewelz Sparkling Mica Pigments](#) to the inside of the ornament by tapping in powders using a [Paintbrush - Detail](#). Repeat with as many colors as you want. Shake the powders inside the ornament to completely cover the inside.
6. When complete, pour diluted black acrylic paint mixture (50% paint/50% water) into ornament. Coat the inside of the ornament by turning until completely covered.
7. Turn the ornament upside down and place in the same plastic cup used for adhesive to drain in, and allow to drain and dry completely again.
8. Replace metal top on ornament.

Tips

- Spray the outside of glass ornament with [Webbing and/or Glitter Spray](#).
- Use a [Fine Liner](#) to personalize your ornament. Fill the [Fine Liner](#) with [Duo Adhesive](#) and let it dry. Dust on [Jewelz - Sparkling Mica Pigments](#) or [Gildenglitz](#), and personalize your ornament.
- [Jewelz - Sparkling Mica Pigments](#) come in 40 pearlescent colors, so try making several ornaments to decorate your home for the holidays!
