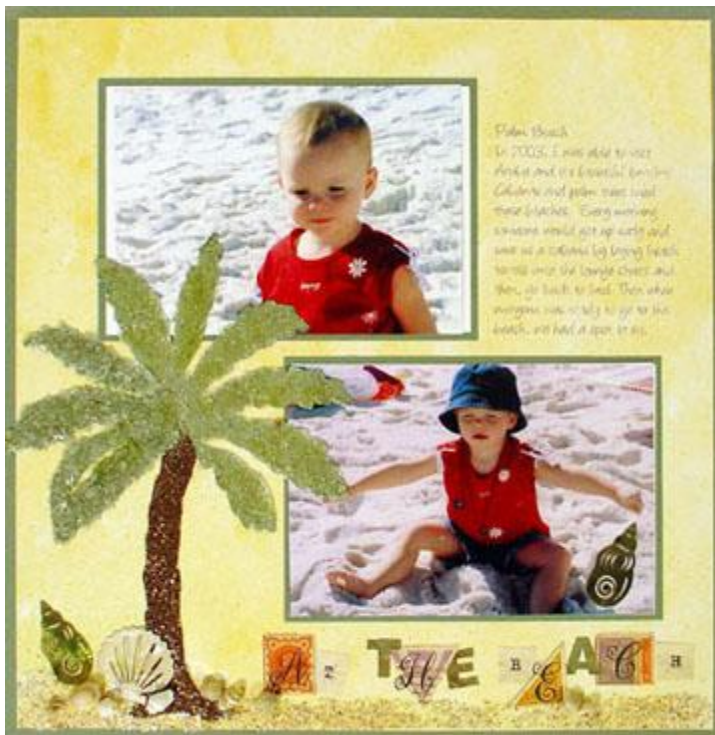


Scrapbooking – Mica Flakes

Materials

- Photos
- Large die-cut or hand-cut palm tree
- [Perfect Paper Adhesive - Gloss](#)
- [Mica Flakes](#) – Green, Antique Bronze, Sparkling Champagne.
- Small Shells
- Sticker letters and embellishing shells
- [Studio Paper](#) (for transferring words and photos)
- [Great Tape](#)

Directions

1. Overlapping photographs with the other elements help to unify the composition
2. Coat the tree with [Perfect Paper Adhesive - Gloss](#) and liberally sprinkle on the various [Mica Flakes](#) . Use the [Mica Flakes](#) - Sparkling Champagne as sparkling sand, and more [Perfect Paper Adhesive - Gloss](#) to adhere the shells.
3. Type your words into the computer and print them out “BEST” and in reverse, onto the [Studio Paper](#) Turn it onto the scrapbook paper, positioning the words where you want them. Gently rub the [Studio Paper](#) from behind, thus transferring the words to the scrapbook page.
4. Adhere all the elements, photos and tree to the page using [Great Tape](#)
