

## Textile Fibers – Easy Dicrofiber Impressions

### Materials

- [Dicrofiber Fusible Fibers®](#)
- [Sandi Miller Art Stamps](#) – or any red, grey or green rubber. (Polymer or Clear Stamps are unsuitable for this technique as the iron temperatures are too high, and will melt clear stamps.)
- [Great Tape®](#)
- Embossing Ink - Black (We like to use Versa Fine)
- Household Iron – set on medium

### Directions

1. Heat an iron to a medium setting.
2. Lay the stamp rubber side up, and ink stamp.
3. Apply [Dicrofiber Fusible Fibers®](#) (a few different colors) over the inked stamp.
4. Place parchment paper over fibers.
5. Set hot iron onto the parchment, for 4 to 6 (quick) seconds or until image begins to show through the parchment.
6. Comb away loose fiber with your fingers, or clip straggly ends with scissors.
7. Attach the fiber image to a card using [Great Tape®](#).

**Tip:** Try using white pigment ink with darker fibers also!
