

Textile Fibers – Advanced Fiber Impressions

Materials

- [DicroFibers®](#)
- [Sandi Miller Art Stamps](#) - Single Iris Stamp
- Embossing Ink – Black
- Household Iron
- [Great Tape®](#)
- [Detail Scissors – ‘Miones®’](#)
- [Perfect Pigment® Acrylic Paint](#) (if desired)
- [Paintbrush](#)

Directions

1. Heat an iron to a medium setting.
2. Lay the stamp rubber side up, and ink stamp.
3. Apply [DicroFibers](#) (a few different colors) over the inked stamp.
4. Place parchment paper over fibers.
5. Set hot iron onto the parchment, about six (quick) seconds or until image shows through the parchment.
6. Do this process again, making 2 complete images.
7. Cut the petals from one of the images, using [Detail Scissors – ‘Miones®’](#)
8. Adhere or stitch the petals from the cut image, over the top of image one – raising them up and creating dimension.
9. Attach the fiber image to a card using [Great Tape](#).
10. Use the [Perfect Pigment® Acrylic Paint](#) (if desired) to emphasize and highlight the stems, petals and other areas of the artwork.

Tip: Try using white pigment ink with darker fibers also.
