Interference Watercolor

1. With a black pigment stamp pad, stamp your image onto vellum paper, and emboss.
2. With a water-based marker, color around the inside of your image, leaving some white space for the next step.
3. Wet the Interference-**MicaColor Watercolor Palette**™.
4. Next, place the brush on the line of the image, and in a small circular motion, draw your brush away from the color, and carry the color to the inside of the image. This will prevent a solid line of color from showing and the marker line will blend with the watercolor, giving it a beautiful iridescent shimmer. "Let the watercolor do it's magic."
5. Mount layers of cardstock using **Great Tape**™.

Note: **Great Tape**™ works great with Vellum and will not show.
